The Georgia Family Connection Partnerships in Catoosa, Chattooga, Dade, & Walker Counties are pleased to provide the UR CHOICE/ UR DESTINY TEEN MAZE for all 10th grade, sophomore students this year at the Colonnade in Ringgold.

TEEN MAZE is a life-sized interactive role-play where students navigate stations that offer real life choices & risky behaviors such as drinking & driving, drug abuse, teen pregnancy, contracting an STD, and facing Juvenile Court! Along the path, health experts present information to help them handle the problems they might face as a result of their behaviors. Since paths are randomly assigned, no two students will have the same experience, much as in real life! The ultimate goal of TEEN MAZE is on-time high school graduation!

In this game, students are victims of chance and must experience whatever happens to them – but, of course, in real life, they have choices! This event is designed to improve student’s knowledge of health risks and realize it is UR CHOICE/ UR DESTINY! Students will be encouraged to learn from their peers’ experiences in the maze and to discuss their experiences with their parents.

Heritage High School students (10th grade) will board Catoosa County School buses and travel to and from the Colonnade for this field trip. There is NO COST for this field trip. Students who do not attend will go to their regular classes.
