## Hybrid Schedule for students in Cohort A

### Fall 2020

HHS will operate on a hybrid schedule for the fall semester of 2020 (August-December) in order to lower class sizes and to make social distancing possible in most classrooms. There are daily expectations for students who are in Cohort A (*students with last names beginning with A-J*).

#### Monday

- **Attend classes in person.** Classes begin at 8:00 am and dismissal will be at 3:25 pm. Students will follow the bell schedule for all 4 classes including lunch. Academic teachers will be available for the first part of lunch each day. Elective teachers will have office hours on Monday or Tuesday and will post these office hours outside of their classroom. Students may be assigned to W.I.N. time (What I Need) for the first part of lunch and are expected to attend. W.I.N. time is designed to help students who may be struggling with essential content or may be behind in their work.

- **Attend classes in person.**

#### Wednesday

- **Check Google Classroom for each class and complete assignments**
- **Students need to plan for Google Meets for their classes between 12:00 and 3:00 pm.** These live Google Meets are by teacher invitation and may be whole class or small group. Students will receive notice of a Google Meet the day before and are expected to participate. Teachers may assign a participation grade. Students who have a conflict are expected to contact their teacher ahead of time.
- Teacher office hours are 7:45 am to 10:00 am and 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

- Students should take notice of due dates for assignments and complete their work on time.
