

HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL FRESHMAN REGISTRATION GUIDE FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR

Students take a total of 8 classes each year. You are already scheduled for 4 academic classes (list of Freshmen level academic core classes is listed on the back of this page) recommended by your teachers and 2 courses required for graduation (Health/P.E. and From Here to Career).

During February registration you will choose your electives and alternates for the next school year.

HOPE Rigor requirements: Over 4 years of high school, students must graduate with a 3.0 or higher average in all **core** classes and earn 4 credits from the Rigor Classes list (found on the HHS website) in order to be eligible for HOPE Scholarships or Zell Miller Scholarships.

Choose 1 or 2 electives depending on how many you need to add up to 8.
