#### HERITAGE HIGH SCHOOL SOPHOMORE REGISTRATION GUIDE FOR THE 2024-25 SCHOOL YEAR

Students take a total of 8 classes each year. You are already scheduled for 4 academic classes recommended by your teachers (academic core classes are listed on the back of this page). During February registration you will choose your electives and alternates for the next school year.

<u>HOPE Rigor requirements:</u> Over 4 years of high school, students must graduate with a 3.0 or higher average in all *core* classes and earn 4 credits from the Rigor Classes list (found on the HHS website) in order to be eligible for HOPE Scholarships or Zell Miller Scholarships.

## **STEP 1: WORLD LANGUAGE?**

HHS students who plan to attend a 4 year college/university typically take 2 semesters of a World Language during their sophomore year. World Language classes are NOT required for high school graduation, but 2 semesters of a World Language are required for admission to some colleges and universities. Two of our computer classes (Computer Science Principles & Programming, Games, Apps are considered World Language classes).

## STEP 2: ELECTIVES

**Select 4 classes under Requested Classes** 

Use the "Elective Quick Reference" and/or "Career Pathways" list to choose 4 more classes from the Career Technology/Agriculture Department, Fine Arts Department, Physical Education Department, World Language Department or academic electives from English, Math, Science or Social Studies Departments.

#### **STEP 3: ALTERNATES**

Select 3 Alternates in case the electives you have requested are full. Enter these under Alternate Courses \*If you have followed steps correctly, you should have 16 out of 16 Requested Units.

## **STEP 4: REVIEW**

You should be scheduled for 16/16 units once complete. If you wish to request a change for the academic classes selected by your teachers, please complete an "Academic Course Schedule Request" form and turn it in to the school counseling office by June 1, 2024
